

Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow (the Doxology) Thomas Ken, 1674

Praise God from Whom all blessings flow.

Praise- tell what's good about
Blessing- any good thing that happened

Reach toward heaven. God is with us, but we also think of Him as above us in heaven.

Praise Him all creatures here below.

Psalm 103:22

Reach arms out, and spin around slowly.

Praise Him above you heavenly hosts.

Point toward heaven. Angels are among us, but many of them are in heaven.

Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.

God is three persons, the Father in heaven, the Son who is Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost who dwells with us now. God is only one God.

Father- bring right hand down in front of face with open palm

Son- touch shoulder*

Holy Ghost- touch other shoulder

Amen.

Amen- means I am in agreement
Bring hands together in traditional prayer stance.

*Orthodox Christians touch right then left. Roman Catholics touch left then right
